### WILDLIFE ACT 1975


#### GENERAL SCHOOL AUTHORISATION

Pursuant to the provisions of the **Wildlife Act 1975**, permission is hereby granted to:

This Authorisation allows the Principal (and delegated staff) of all registered Victorian government schools to acquire, retain on school premises and sell or give away the species of wildlife listed in **Attachment 1**, for the purpose of education (excluding the conduct of experiments other than those involving non-invasive observations) subject to the following conditions:

1. Wildlife must not be taken from or released to the wild. Wildlife may only be obtained from and disposed of to the holder of a commercial wildlife (dealer) licence or Private Wildlife Licence, the Amphibian Research Centre, or any other person authorised in writing by the Secretary of the Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE).
2. A person acquiring wildlife on behalf of a school must present a copy of this Authorisation to any person providing the wildlife and must also provide written authorisation signed by the principle on school letterhead, authorising that person to act under this Authorisation and on their behalf.
3. The Principal may Authorise a person in writing to care for any wildlife held under this Authority, including maintenance of any wildlife at their private residence during school holidays. Wildlife **MUST** be kept on the school premises at all other times excepting in the case of removal for veterinary treatment or disposal.
4. A bound record book detailing all transactions involving wildlife (including name, licence number and address of supplier, species, quantities of wildlife involved, and transaction date) must be kept at the school and made available for inspection to an Authorised Officer on demand.
5. A record book must be surrendered to an Authorised Officer on demand.
6. A clear label is to be fixed to every tank or enclosure used in connection with this Authorisation, showing "Wildlife Authorisation Number 10004669" - wildlife **must not** be taken from the wild.
7. The provisions of the **Wildlife Act 1975** and the **Wildlife Regulations 2002** are to be observed, except where exemption is specifically provided for in this Authorisation.
8. The direction of any authorised officer of the Department of Sustainability and Environment, in relation to this Authorisation, must be complied with.
9. All live specimens are to be properly housed, fed and cared for in order to maintain their good health.

10. At any time, an Authorised Officer may remove any specimen from a collection held under this Authorisation.
11. Failure to comply with any condition of this Authorisation may result in its cancellation, at the discretion of the Secretary. The Secretary may also exclude any individual school from the permission of this Authorisation where any condition of this Authorisation has been breached, or an offence under the **Wildlife Act 1975** or **Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1986** has been committed.
12. This Authorisation shall, unless revoked, remain in force until **31 October 2011**.
