About the Ballot

- Entry fee to the ballot is **\$15.00 AUD**
- All deer are free ranging
- The hunting is conducted in reserves near Bairnsdale, Victoria, Australia and managed by Parks Victoria.
- Surveys will be carried out in the balloted areas to set the 2010 harvest.
- The number of people hunting during each balloted period between March 2010 and June 2010 will be limited.

Conditions

1. Only one application is allowed per hunter.
2. Only hog deer may be taken in the hunting period drawn.
3. The Blond Bay Hog Deer Advisory Group reserves the right to specify the sex and number of deer to be harvested.
4. Camping is only permitted at a specified site within the hunting area.
5. Balloted hunters must hunt their allocated period; another period will not be made available on request.
6. Hunts are non-transferable.

The ballot will be drawn shortly after the closing date and successful hunters will be notified by DSE.
