



# Bayley Street, Transit Place & Clare Street Upgrades

The Victorian Government is investing in better connected communities.

Through the \$24.5 million Geelong Transit City project, streetscape works are being undertaken to improve pedestrian safety and amenity around Central Geelong.

## What are the works?

The works along Bayley Street, Transit Place and Clare Street include:

- new and upgraded street lighting
- new street trees and landscaping
- new street furniture and paving
- improvements to drainage and kerb alterations.

The works are creating stronger links between key Geelong areas and improving the walkability, making more businesses and retail areas in Central Geelong only a stroll away.

## Streetscape benefits

The streetscape upgrades provide a number of benefits, including:

- a safer pedestrian environment
- better connections from the Railway Station to the TAC building, the waterfront and the retail core of central Geelong
- strengthening the station's integration, both visually and functionally, with central Geelong
- the works will complement the proposed streetscape upgrades in Corio Street being undertaken by the City of Greater Geelong.

## Next steps

Contractors have been appointed for Bayley Street and Transit Place and tenders will be announced shortly for Clare Street.

It is anticipated that the improvements will be completed by the mid-late 2009.

This project is being delivered in partnership with the City of Greater Geelong and the Department of Planning and Community Development.
