## Program Management

1. At the instigation of the Imagery Assurance Group (IAG), following feedback from stakeholders of the Program, Guidelines for Access, Pricing, Intellectual Property and Licensing for Imagery and Elevation Products have been produced for use by existing and potential stakeholders of the Program. The Guidelines have been developed in accord with the Business Model for the Coordinated Imagery Program.

The Guidelines aim to outline details on access, charging, storage, intellectual property and licensing arrangements for the products acquired, stored and distributed by the Program.

2. A Statement on Intellectual Property and Licensing of the Program's Products has also been prepared for existing and potential stakeholders of the Program, to assist stakeholders with guidance when providing copies of their imagery to external customers and organisations. ## Tender Release - Spatial Imagery and Elevation Products Panel – State Purchase Contract

3. A panel of providers for Spatial Imagery and Elevation Products for Victorian Government Departments, Agencies and Purchase Partners is being established for the period 2008-2010. The Panel Members will provide services such as the provision of orthophotography, elevation data and related value adding services.

The Program Team via Spatial Information Infrastructure (SII) an agency of DSE, will coordinate the establishment and administration of the Panel on behalf of Purchase Partners. The Request for Tender (RFT) will facilitate the continuation of the coordinated program of acquisition of spatial imagery and elevation products which began in 2003.

The Tender was released and advertised in the Herald Sun on 6 February. Tenders closed on 6 March 2008. The tender process is progressing satisfactorily with the new panel scheduled to be in place for July 1 2008.
