PROGRAM MANAGEMENT 2009-10 Expressions of Interest

COMMUNICATION MANAGEMENT

The second batch of online purchase partner feedback surveys forwarded in the last three months, received a 45% participation rate from recipients.

In response to the feedback received from purchase partners and sourced from these surveys, the CIP Team, starting this flying season, will be asking contractors to maintain project status information via a free Wiki Web Utility called WetPaint (an information sharing tool).

Currently, the proposed use of a Wiki for reporting on CIP project status is a trial. As the Wiki we are using is a free utility it does come with some unwanted features such as advertising. However, if the basic concept proves to be efficient and an improvement on previous reporting processes, CIP will look at implementing something more tailored to meet partners specific needs.

Access to the Wiki will be controlled by the CIP Team and will be by invitation only. All users will automatically receive an email if their project Wiki has had any updates. Once a project is complete the project Wiki will be closed by CIP.

We will update the CIP Purchase Partner Survey to allow for feedback on this trial reporting mechanism. In the meantime, feel free to contact your CIP representative and let them know your experience with this system, as it will help us decide on the next appropriate steps.

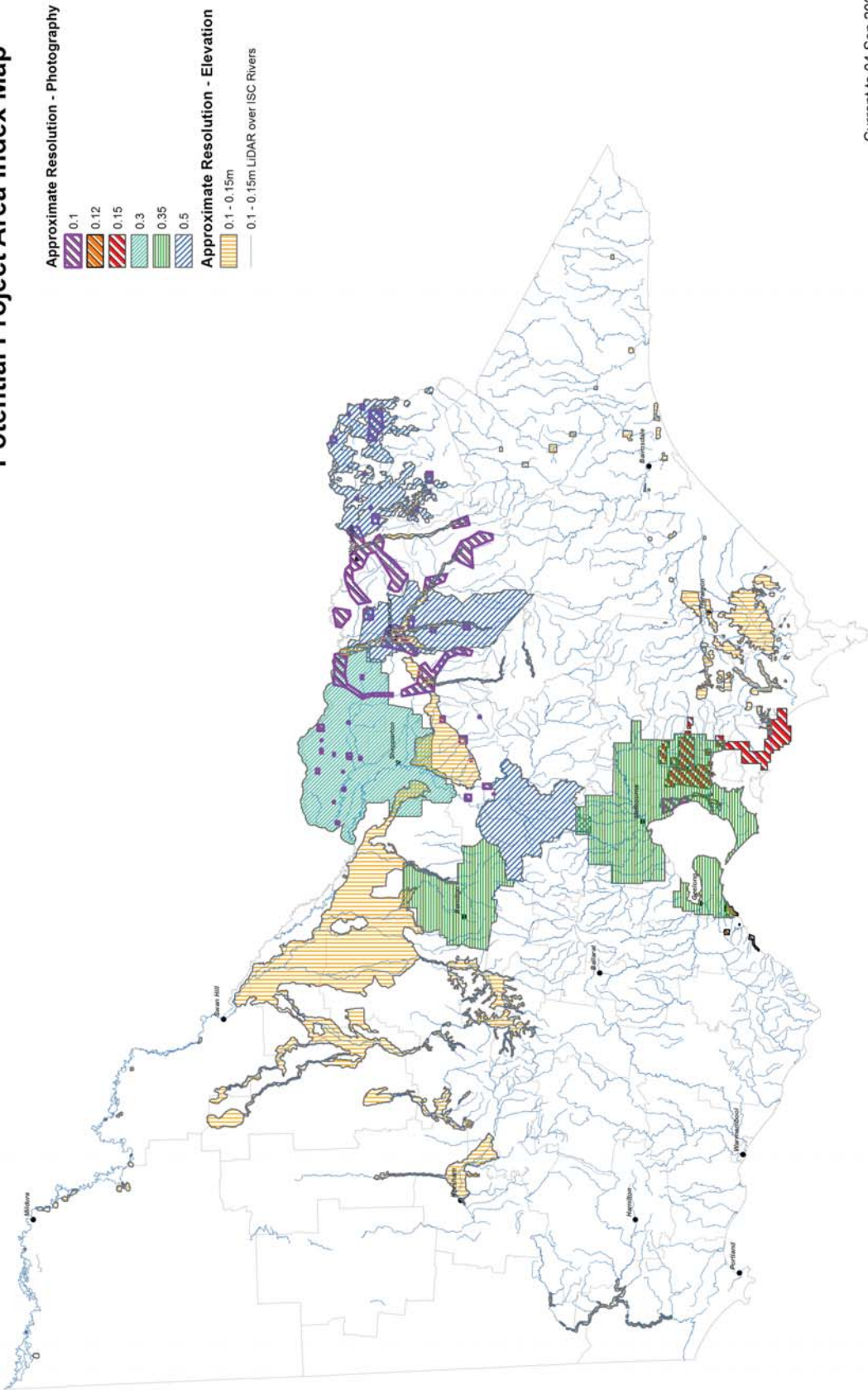
STATE PURCHASE CONTRACT FOR SPATIAL IMAGERY AND ELEVATION PRODUCTS

The current CIP Panel has been in operation for just over a year and undertook 33 projects during the 2008-09 period. There were a total of 41 purchase partners across the 30 aerial and 3 elevation projects.

The requirements of all 33 projects completed through the panel were able to be serviced by the range of panel member companies.
